

Remote Access for Windows

Once you have logged on to the laptop you will see a **'Blue Circle'** by the clock in the bottom right-hand corner of your screen. You may need to click on the ^ to show it.



Click the blue icon, a window will pop up; Authenticate User. In the logon box that appears, enter your regular network username and password.
