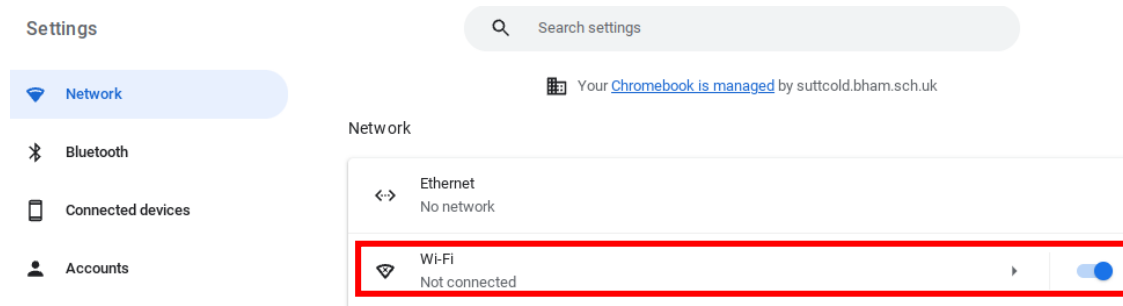


# Connecting to Wi-Fi on a Chromebook

When using your own Chromebook, you can connect to the school Wi-Fi using your regular school username and password.

Open **Settings**, then select the **Network** tab on the menu. This will display a list of the available Wi-Fi options. Select **SCGSG-Secure** from the list.

You should not attempt to connect to any other listed network unless you have been asked to do so by the IT Support Department.



To connect you will have to select settings within the WiFi connection.

<b>Domain suffix match:</b>	<b>Leave this blank</b>
<b>Identity:</b>	<b>Enter Username</b>
<b>Password:</b>	<b>Enter Password</b>
<b>Anonymous identity:</b>	<b>Leave this blank</b>

This is your usual **Username** and **Password** that you login to the school computer with. For example, *23student* and your usual school password.

Once you have entered your login details press **Connect**.

You are now connected to the school Wi-Fi, it will state **Connected** in your **Network** settings.
