We are excited to tell you that we have three fabulous authors joining us this year. Jaspreet Kaur, a spoken word poet and motivational speaker, will join us for a special assembly, talking about her life and career and about her book 'Brown Girl Like Me.' Simon James Green will be talking to us about his bestselling novels which include 'Life of Reilly' and 'Alex in Wonderland'. A.M Dassu, World Book Day author and bestseller will be discussing her books 'Boy Everywhere', 'Fight Back' and 'Boot It!'

Both Simon James Green and A.M. Dassu will be signing books for us in the library during their visit, and Waterstones will be here with a pop-up bookshop if students would like to buy a signed book as a lovely memento. Prices start from £6.99, and purchases must be made with cash only.

We don't want anybody to miss out on the opportunity, so students are welcome to bring in payment for the book earlier that week, and we will arrange to have it signed and dedicated to them.
