For students in Years 10–13, subject-specific 'checklists' have been replaced with more detailed progress statements. These are designed to support meaningful conversations at home around your child's learning, and to provide insight into the feedback they receive from their teachers.

For students in Years 7–9, the current 'checklists' remain available on the website and will be transitioned to the new format by the end of the autumn term. Please revisit this area of the website periodically for updates.

In addition to these curriculum updates, we have developed a new **Assessment & Reporting Policy**, which outlines how we monitor and report on student progress. Progress Reports will continue to be issued throughout the academic year via the Satchel One app. We have standardised the language used across all year groups when reporting on *Independent Study* and *Approach to Learning*, while progress statements will be tailored to reflect the expectations of each year group.
